### Explanation of the scores

- 0 - Undrinkable** – No Cask Ale available or so poor you have to take it back or can't finish it
- 1 - Poor** - Beer that is anything from barely drinkable to drinkable with considerable resentment
- 2 - Average** – competently kept, drinkable pint but doesn't inspire in any way, not worth moving to another pub but you drink the beer without really noticing
- 3 - Good** – Good Beer in good form. You may cancel plans to move on to the next pub. You want to stay for another pint and may seek out the beer again
- 4 - Very Good** – Excellent Beer in excellent condition
- 5 - Perfect** – Probably the best beer you are likely to find. A seasoned drinker will award this score very rarely
