



# Tendring CAMRA RambAle route 6

## Wrabness Community Café to Harwich

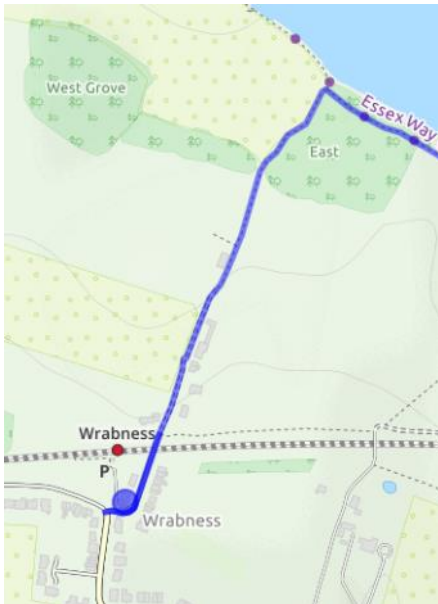
Start: Wrabness

Finish: Harwich

Distance: 7.4 miles

### Wrabness Community Café to Castle, Ramsey

Total distance : 2.8 miles



Turn left out of the café and walk down Black Boy Lane, over the railway bridge, past 'A House for Essex' (by Grayson Perry) until you reach the Essex Way just before the shores of the Stour Estuary. Turn right and follow the waymarked trail (marked with the two poppies symbol shown here) until you reach the Castle at Ramsey.



## Castle, Ramsey to Captain Fryatt, Parkeston.

Distance: 2.4 miles



Turn left out of the Castle and left at the junction. Just after Orchard Close on the left will be a footpath on your right that you need to follow. This joins Ray Lane where you turn right. Follow this road past the sewage works, then between the refinery and the golf course until you reach Refinery Road. Follow this into West Dock Road, then just after the derelict petrol station and before the roundabout take the foot path right past the postbox, which is also the start of the UK section of the North Sea Cycle Route. Follow the cycle route signs along Collier Road and down Hamilton Street to the Captain Fryatt.

## Captain Fryatt, Parkeston to Kings Arms, Dovercourt

Distance: 1.6 miles



Turn right out of the Captain Fryatt and continue following the cycle route signs until you reach Dovercourt station. Carry on with the station on your left, then turn right into Victoria Street. The King's Arms is at the other end of this street.

## Kings Arms, Dovercourt to Harwich

Distance: 0.6 miles



Turn left out of the Kings Arms along High Street into Main Road. Follow this road until you reach the station/High Lighthouse junction. From here Harwich has a number of pubs to enjoy within a short distance.

For Wrabness it is easiest to arrive by train, though this requires a couple of changes from Clacton. Alternatively take the bus to Manningtree or Harwich first. The 103 from Colchester to Harwich via Manningtree stops at the bottom of Rectory Road. Online route planners estimate an 11 minute (uphill) walk to the station.
